Currently, Alfonso Aldeanueva is a substitute violin in Orquesta Sinfónica de Madrid- Teatro Real. Furthermore, he plays regularly in Orquesta Nacional de España OCNE. During 2015-2016, he has temporal contract (1<sup>st</sup> violin 4/6/8 position) in Orquesta Ciudad de Granada. He has played under the bats of Kent Nagano, Juanjo Mena, Benini, Pablo Heras, Pinchas Steinberg, Dan Ettinger and Simone Young.

He has attended masterclasses with Ivry Gitlis, Rainer Küchl, Ilya Gringolts, Stephan Picard, Rainer Schmidt Carolin Widmann and Casals Quartet. Completed his bachelor's degree in ESMUC (Barcelona) with prof. Yuri Volguin, he continued his studies in Vienna with prof. Igor Petrushevski as postgraduate program and master solo performance in Madrid with prof. Zorhab Tadevosyan.

He received 'Borsa di Studio' *Livorno Festival* 2015- with prof. Ivry Gitlis, 2<sup>nd</sup> prize *Barcelona String Competition* in 2014 and 1<sup>st</sup> prize *Córdoba's National Violin Competition* in 2015. In chamber music duo, Alfonso has been performing with Miguel Pisonero since 2010, winning several competitions including 1<sup>st</sup> prize *Hazen Award* in Chamber Music. He participated in Grumiaux Violin Competition and Dvarionas Violin International Competition being Semifinalist in the last one.
